


# A NEW EXPERIENCE IS COMING TO DISCREPANCY REPORTING.

Enhancements to the discrepancy reporting form will be unveiled this July.


Access to the form remains the same but you'll experience these new features:

Use a **checklist** to build your discrepancy form. Choose only those sections of the profile where you believe a change is needed.

**Instructional detail** clarifies what information you need to provide. This helps ensure a quicker, more successful investigation by our AMA data team.

The addition of **drop-down menus** eliminates extra work for you while standardizing the data you provide.

## ALWAYS REMEMBER...

- ✓ A discrepancy report for a physician or PA profile can be submitted within 180 days of your profile purchase.
- ✓ Discrepancy reports should be filed any time you believe data on an AMA Physician Profile or AMA PA Profile is in question.
- ✓ The discrepancy investigation process is thorough and often requires the AMA to contact one or more primary sources to validate data. Working with the primary sources adds a layer of complexity and time to the process.
- ✓ AMA will report results by email within 30 days of your report submission. If the investigation results in a change to the profile, an updated profile will be made available for download within AMA Profiles Hub. You will have 30 days to access that updated profile.
